MINUTES OF MEETING CONWAY CONSERVATION COMMISSION September 12, 2012

The Sept. meeting of the Conway Conservation Commission convened at 6:30 p.m. at the Whitaker Homesite in North Conway, NH. Members present were: Rob Adair, Linda Kearney and Karla Allen. Also present was Forester, Don Johnson, as well as representatives from USVLT, Executive Director William Abbott and Board member Tom Gross, along with the owner of F.B. Environmental, Forrest Bell.

There being no quorum present, no action was taken on approval of Minutes and no reports were given.

Messrs. Abbott and Gross, on behalf of USVLT presented the Natural Resources Inventory covering the area from Hart's Location to Denmark, ME and including Madison, Albany and Eaton. A copy of the document is on file at the Conway Town Hall.

As part of the presentation a Build Out Analysis projecting future development was provided by Forrest Bell. He stated this would be held in the spring of 2013 and Conway will be notified when a date has been set.
