

INVITATION TO BID

The **Town of Conway** will receive sealed Bids for the NH ROUTE 16 / NH ROUTE 113 / NH ROUTE 153 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS until **2:00 PM on January 22, 2026** at the Town of Conway Town Hall at 23 Main Street, Conway, NH, 03818, attention Jim Badera, Town Engineer, at which time and place they will be opened and publicly read.

This Federally funded project involves reconfiguring the NH Route 16 and NH Route 113 intersection and reconstructing, realigning, and widening the respective roadways and approaches. The work will include signalization improvements at both intersections, drainage improvements, retaining wall construction, stormwater management, traffic signage and pavement markings, temporary traffic control, and other associated work to facilitate construction. Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope that is plainly marked:

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cash, check drawn by a New Hampshire bank, or bid bond for and subject to conditions provided in the Instruction to Bidders. The amount of such bid deposit shall be five percent (5%) of the total bid, made payable to the Town of Conway, New Hampshire.

A non-mandatory pre-bid informational meeting will be held at 11:00 AM on January 6, 2026 at the Town of Conway Town Hall at 23 Main Street, Conway, NH, 03818.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond and a separate payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.
