

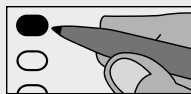

**ARTICLE 2**

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$54,443** to be added to the **Expendable Trust Fund (New Kennett High School Facilities Maintenance Fund)** established for that purpose in 2007, with **\$36,020** to offset this amount from the sending towns and the remainder to be raised by general taxation. (Special Article by definition) (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 12-1-1). This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article 6, the operating budget. (Majority vote required)

**ARTICLE 3**

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$17,086** to be added to the **Expendable Trust Fund (A. Crosby Kennett Middle School Facilities Maintenance Fund)** established for that purpose in 2007, with **\$7,564** to offset this amount from the sending towns and the remainder to be raised by general taxation. (Special Article by definition) (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 12-1-1). This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article 6, the operating budget. (Majority vote required)

**ARTICLE 4**

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$9,900** to be added to the **Expendable Trust Fund (Elementary Schools Facilities Maintenance Fund)** established for that purpose in 2007, with **\$1,104** to offset this amount from the sending towns and the remainder to be raised by general taxation. (Special Article by definition) (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 12-1-1). This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article 6, the operating budget. (Majority vote required)

**ARTICLE 5**

To see if the School District will vote to approve the cost items included in the collective bargaining agreement reached between the Conway School Board and the **Conway Educational Support Personnel (CESP)** which calls for the following increase in salaries and benefits at the current staffing levels:

Fiscal Year	Fiscal Year Estimated Increase
2025-26	\$ 413,087
2026-27	\$ 122,200
2027-28	\$ 144,172

and further to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$413,087** for the upcoming fiscal year, such sum representing the additional costs attributable to the increase in salaries and benefits required by the new agreement over those that would be paid at current staffing levels. The total compounded cost of the three year agreement is \$1,627,833. (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 7-6-1). This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article 6, the operating budget.

**ARTICLE 6**

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate as an **Operating Budget**, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling **\$41,637,542** with **\$1,575,500** to offset this amount from various grants. (Recommended by the School Board 5-1-0) (Not Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 6-7-0). Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be **\$40,986,456** which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Conway School District or by law, or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

**ARTICLE 7**

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$88,000** to supplement the funding of the **Lakeside Primary School and Mountainside Intermediate School's Project SUCCEED Programs**. (Designated as a Special Article)(Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0)(Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 10-3-1). This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article 6, the operating budget.

**ARTICLE 8**

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$250,000** to be added to the **Capital Reserve Fund (Equipment and/or School Buses)** established for this purpose in 2019. (Special Article by definition) (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 8-5-1). This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article 6, the operating budget.

**ARTICLE 9**

To see if the School District will vote to raise and appropriate **\$1,840,000** to be placed in the **Expendable Trust Fund (School Buildings Maintenance Fund)** established for that purpose in 1995. (Special Article by definition) (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 8-5-1). This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article 6, the operating budget.

**ARTICLE 10**

To see if the School District will vote to **establish an Expendable Trust Fund** under the provisions of RSA 198:20-c to be known as the **Safety and Security Trust Fund** for the purposes of upgrades and maintenance of safety and security items and measures and to raise and appropriate the sum of **\$100,000** to be placed in this fund. Further, to name the Conway School Board as agents to expend from said fund. (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 9-3-2). This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article 6, the operating budget. (Majority Vote Required)

**ARTICLE 11**

To see if the Conway School District will raise and appropriate **\$214,160** for the purpose of Design Phase Services including the development of technical specifications and drawings, suitable for competitively bidding the project to contractors, for the **Kennett High School Main Entrance Relocation and Associated Work project**. (Special Article by definition) (Recommended by the School Board 6-1-0) (Not Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 5-7-2). This appropriation is in addition to Warrant Article 6, the operating budget.

**ARTICLE 12**

To see if the Conway School District will raise and appropriate up to **\$500,000** to be placed in the **Expendable Trust Fund (School Buildings Maintenance Fund)** established for that purpose in 1995. This sum is to come from June 30, 2025 fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2025. No amount to be raised from new taxation. (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 7-6-1).

**ARTICLE 13**

To see if the Conway School District will raise and appropriate up to **\$500,000** to be placed in the **Expendable Trust Fund (Safety and Security Trust Fund)**. This sum is to come from June 30, 2025 fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2025. No amount to be raised from new taxation. This article is contingent on the passage of Warrant Article 10. In the event of non-passage of Warrant Article 10, this article will be considered null and void. (Recommended by the School Board 7-0-0) (Not Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 6-7-1).

**ARTICLE 14**

Petitioned Warrant Article: This is a special petitioned warrant article submitted by a Conway voter (supported with requisite signatures). To see if the voters of the Conway School District will vote to direct the Conway School Board to redesignate Lakeside Primary School, so-called, as Pine Tree Primary School, and to redesignate Mountainside Intermediate School, so-called, as Conway Intermediate School, thus restoring the historic names of those schools as far as possible while still distinguishing them by grade level. (Not Recommended by the Conway School Board 2-4-0) (Recommended by the Municipal Budget Committee 6-4-3).
