



REGISTERING TO VOTE

Live Free or Die!

To register and vote in New Hampshire, you must provide documents proving your:



Identity



Age (18-years of age or older on election day)



United States citizenship

* REAL ID is **NOT** proof of citizenship



Domicile (Permanent Residence)

* the one place where a person, more than any other place, has established a physical presence and manifests an intent to maintain a single continuous presence for domestic, social, and civil purposes relevant to participating in democratic self-government.

How Do I Register to Vote?

With proof of Identity and documents that verify the above you may register:



With your local town or city clerk up until the Supervisors of the Checklist final meeting before an election.

or

At a scheduled and public session of your local Supervisors of the Checklist meeting (they must meet every 90 days); OR on a date the SOC choose that is 6-13 days before an election.

or

At your polling location on election day.

or

By absentee, if you qualify.
