Note: it is the responsibility of the property owner/project manager to ensure that all contractors employed to do work have applied and received all necessary permits. It is also the responsibility of same to insure that all inspections required are completed. If work has not begun within one year of issuance, permit it becomes null and void.

Electricians must have a valid license from the State of New Hampshire to obtain a permit. Permits are not transferable.

The property owner of record may exercise their right to perform their own electrical work on their residence if it is a single family dwelling and owner occupied

This signed application constitutes consent on the applicant's part to allow for all inspections at the property location listed.

No permit will be issued until all of the above information is furnished, and all the above conditions met. It is the responsibility of the property owner and/ or the contractor to contact your local utility after Town approval to schedule connection.

INSPECTIONS REQUIRED: (48 hours' notice required)

1. Underground conduit installations.

- 2. When service is installed and a work order number has been obtained from your local utility.
- 3. When rough-in is complete and visible (Rough).
- 4. When job is complete, but before occupancy (Final).

The Building Department approval would certify that the applicant could proceed with installation of electrical fixtures in accordance with specifications submitted. Any deviation from the specifications submitted will require an amendment to this permit or additional permits.
