# CONWAY SEPTIC SYSTEM APPLICATION

Revised January 1, 1994, Latest Revision June 23, 2020

1. An application must be filled out in full and submitted to the Town Building Inspector.
2. One copy of the septic plan must be submitted, the Town will retain this copy.
3. All bodies of water within 125' of the system must be shown on the septic plan, including lakes, rivers, ponds and streams.
4. All setbacks from septic systems and buildings to any body of water, road right-of-way or lot line must be clearly noted.
5. All plans received will be reviewed within seven days.
6. All septic systems that exist within 125 feet of a great pond will have to conform to Section C of the Town of Conway Septic Ordinance.
