



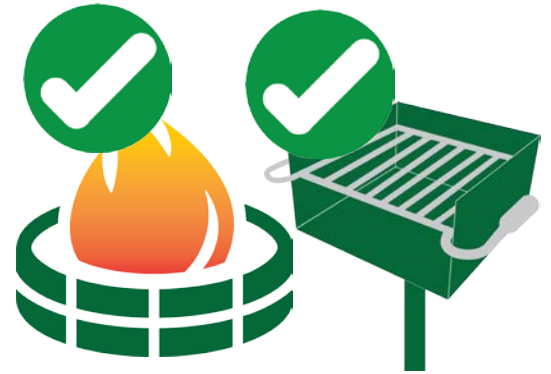

White Mountain National Forest Restrictions



CAMPFIRES

Prohibited: Building, maintaining, attending, or using a fire, campfire, charcoal, or wood grill outside of a Forest Service provided metal fire pit, metal fire ring, or pole mounted grill at a developed campground or developed recreation site.



Locations Where Fires Will be Allowed in Fire Rings and Grills

You can have a fire in a Forest Service provided metal fire pit, metal fire ring, or pole mounted grill at these campgrounds and recreation areas:
