42 ➤ Review of Outstanding Minutes:

47 ➤ **Chair LeFebvre** noted some areas of interest for this year:

48 • The April 22, 2019 Conway School Board meeting regarding the suggestion to have an Ad
49 Hoc Committee to investigate closing a school. This committee would evaluate the cost
50 savings of closing a school and the benefits to the town, if any.

51 • It is suggested the board anticipate the Pre-K proposal again this year.

52 • A new 3-year contract will be negotiated this year for the teachers.

54 ➤ **Mr. Mosca** commented on the suggested Ad Hoc Committee at the School Board level. The
55 committee would look at the study, update the numbers, and come back it back to the voters.
56 If the voters elect to close a school, the School Board will be the deciding body to designate
57 which school will close. **Chair LeFebvre** reminded members the voters approved upgrades
58 to all 3 elementary schools.

60 ➤ **Chair LeFebvre** recommended a sub-committee be reinstated to work on budgetary
61 questions for the town and school.

62 • A discussion ensued concerning the individualized questions, remaining unbiased, getting
63 responsibility of getting the “biggest bang for the buck”, and making the voters more aware
64 and involved.

65 **Mr. Mosca moved, seconded by Mr. Turner to form a subcommittee to coordinate all**
66 **questions to be presented to the town and school. Motion Fails. (1 [Chair LeFebvre] –**
67 **11 – 2 [Ms Leonard and Ms. Frechette])**

68 • All questions will be sent to and by the Chair.

70 ➤ **Mr. Colbath** noted a concern for the East Conway Fire Precinct not having representation on
71 the Budget Committee.

72 • Discussion ensued regarding the size of the committee and how the number of 17 members
73 was arrived at.

75 ➤ **Mr. Mosca** commented on the School Board Rep., expressing his gratitude for the dedication
76 and hard work of the committee over the last 9 years. (should he not be appointed to the
77 committee again).
